



Rules governing the 2026 Nova Scotia Liberal Party Leadership Convention

Issued by the Nova Scotia Liberal Party on May 6, 2026

(the “Rules”)

Amendment No. 1

Recitals

- A. The Leadership Convention will be held on November 21, 2026 in accordance with the Rules;
- B. The authority to amend the Rules has been delegated to the Chief Electoral Officer (“CEO”) by the Provincial Board and Leadership Committee of the Nova Scotia Liberal Party;
- C. Certain of the dates set out in the Rules need to be adjusted to align with the date of the Leadership Convention;
- D. For reasons of administrative simplicity, the Delegate Fee will be reduced from two levels to one level.

Now therefore the CEO hereby enacts the following amendments:

1. Definition of “Delegate” - The definition of “Delegate” in Paragraph 1 of the Rules is deleted and replaced with the following:

“Delegate” means a Member who has registered or re-registered as a Member, has complied with the procedures set out in these Rules to register as a Delegate, and has been assigned a PIN for the purpose of registering their vote in the leadership election;

2. Definition of “Member” – The definition of “Member” in Paragraph 1 of the Rules is deleted and replaced with the following:

“Member” means a person who is a registered member in good standing of the NSLP as of the applicable time. Eligibility for membership is outlined in the NSLP’s by-laws.

3. Final list of delegates - Paragraph 54 of the Rules is amended by replacing November 4 with November 5th;
4. Delegate Challenges and CEO Ruling - Paragraph 57 of the Rules is amended by replacing November 1 with November 6 for delegate challenges and November 3 with November 10th for the date of the CEO’s ruling on any delegate challenges;
5. Final List - Paragraph 58 of the Rules is amended by replacing November 10 with November 12th;

6. Registration Opens August 17th, following the process on the NSLP Website – Paragraph 75 of the Rules is amended by inserting a new second sentence that reads as follows:

Members may register commencing August 17th, 2026 at 8 am by following the process and meeting the requirements set out on the NSLP website.

7. Delete outdated reference to Delegate procedure - Paragraph 78 is deleted;
8. Delegate eligibility – Paragraph 76(a) of the Rules is amended by deleting the words “having registered by October 21, 2026, at 11:59 p.m.”
9. Voting Opens – Paragraph 81 of the Rules is amended by replacing November 14th with November 16th;
10. Delegate Fee – Paragraph 95 is amended by deleting the current paragraph and replacing it with the following:

A fee of \$25 for all Members will be charged and remitted by any person wishing to be a Delegate. A tax receipt will be issued for the Delegate Fee

A new consolidated version of the Rules, with these Amendments, shall be prepared and issued.
